about How long does the experience last?

The tour takes 1.5 hours in total and includes a tasting of 4 wines. After the the tour you are welcome to order more drinks if you would like.

event What time should I arrive?

Please arrive 5-10 minutes before the event.

What do I have to wear on the tour?

Anything comfortable and suitable for the weather. No boots are required.

Will the event still happen if it's raining? Absolutely! We prefer to hold the events outside in the Wine Garden wherever possible, but we do have our Tasting Room overlooking the vines as a back-up option.

Is there a lot of walking involved with the tour? The walking part of the tour is about 30 minutes, after which you can take your seats for the wine tasting. Please note that the tasting room is at first-floor level with one flight of steps and therefore not accessible to wheelchairs. We also have outside tables dependent on the weather.

How much wine will I be drinking?

The ticket includes 4 x 60ml servings of our wines, with a mix of still and sparkling wines. More wine is available to purchase at the event, to drink or take home.
